Patients with Oral Clefts, dental and Craniofacial syndromes often require multidisciplinary care. The standards for this multidisciplinary approach are rapidly evolving.

This special issue focuses on research in the following areas:

- Further insights in the long term effects of treatment, patient-reported outcome measures, value-based care, Oral Health related Quality of Life
- The role of 3D in craniofacial genetics and new methods in 3D evaluation, including 3D recognition of facial markers for diagnostic or etiological purposes (or 2D in long term studies)
- Use of 3D techniques and/or artificial intelligence to improve evaluation, differential diagnosis or communication with patients with congenital
 - dental malformations (e.g. oligodontia and amelogenesis imperfecta)
 - craniofacial malformations (e.g. craniosynostosis, craniofacial microsomia and oral clefts)
- Combination of precise (sub) phenotyping, epidemiology, genetic and environmental factors leading to new clinical opportunities

Long term studies are encouraged. Well-documented case series on rare malformations are welcome.

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
